Uniform Guide

Rationale

Our identity is important to us. We want the community to know that ‘those well-mannered students are from Kalamunda Christian School.’ When people see our students wearing the uniform well, they will make connections to our character.

We consider that the wearing of a school uniform and being clear on matters of personal appearance:

- Enhances morale, team spirit and pride of students in their School. It is all about belonging.
- Ensures students are safely and appropriately dressed for a range of school activities.
- Encourages equity among students.
- Fosters and enhances perceptions of the school within the wider community.

Wearing a uniform is a badge of pride. It creates an identity for the school, creates uniformity and subtly positions students in a learning mindset. We want students to feel comfortable and have a sense of belonging when they wear their uniform.

In designing the uniform for Kalamunda Christian School, attention was paid to

- Affordability and Functionality
- Style: smart and distinctive
- Durability: easy to wash, dirt-resistant colours and lasting materials

“Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as elaborate hairstyles and the wearing of gold jewellery or fine clothes. Rather, it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God’s sight.”

General Requirements

Hair

- Hair is to be clean, neat and tidy.
- Colour of hair.
 - Hair should be the student’s natural hair colour.
 - Colouring or streaks are not acceptable with the only exception being washout types for designated House Carnivals.
- Style of Hair.
 - Hair should be a standard style.
 - The Principal retains discretion to decide upon acceptable hair standards. Examples of unacceptable styles are hair shaved shorter than “Number 3” length, mullets, undercuts, rats’ tails, overly-gelled hair, spikes, dreadlocks, rails and other styles popular from time to time.
- Length of hair.
 - Fringes must be above eyebrows. Fringes that fall below the eyebrows need to be tied back. No hair should be falling across the face.
 - Hair longer than the top of the shirt collar is to be tied back with a blue, black or white tie, ribbon or small scrunchie. Hair arrangements must allow students to properly wear their hat and while participating in sports.

General Requirements Cont.

Jewellery

All students are only permitted to wear:

- A bracelet for medical reasons
- An official school issued badge
- A wristwatch. *Where a watch causes disruption in class (e.g., an audible alarm, or causing distraction to the student), it will be treated as a device e.g., mobile phone and the ICT Policy will be applied. Smartwatches, trackers, etc. may not be worn during any assessments.*

In addition to these items, girls are permitted to wear:

- One pair of small (5mm) plain gold, silver or clear studs in the lower lobe
- No other piercing is permitted

NOTE: Exemptions for children to wear additional jewellery related to religious significance may be granted by the principal on application by a family.

Hats

In line with the school's Sun Protection policy:

- Only hats listed on the Uniform Guide will be worn.
- Hats will be kept at school in the classrooms for storage all year round.
- All students and staff wear hats that protect their face, neck and ears whenever they are outside. Caps and visors are not considered a suitable alternative.

Year 6 Leavers Shirt/Jackets

Year 6 students will be permitted to wear their leavers shirts/jackets on days designated by their Teacher. Formal school uniform, or if appropriate school sport uniform is required for all excursions unless otherwise notified.

Casual Dress Day

- Clothing is to be modest.
- No skin-tight clothing, including short shorts, leggings and jeggings without covering.
- No singlet or halter neck tops or halter neck dresses.
- No offensive slogans or images on any clothing.
- No bare midriffs.
- Appropriate footwear as determined by the staff member in charge.

Other Matters

- Formal school uniform, or if appropriate school sport uniform is required for all excursions unless otherwise notified. The Teacher in charge of the excursion will advise which is the correct uniform for the event. Students who do not have the full correct uniform may not be allowed to attend the excursion.
- Swimming bathers- female students are to wear one-piece bathers or a rash top and swimming shorts to cover.
- The wearing of sunblock is in keeping with our Sun Protection policy. The school supplies SPF30 (or higher) broad-spectrum, water-resistant sunscreen. If a student brings their own, it must comply with these requirements.
- Clear lip moisturiser is allowed when required.
- Make Up, nail polish, false nails, or nail extensions are not permitted to be worn.
- Close fitting wraparound sunglasses that comply with Australian standards are encouraged but optional. Sunglasses can only be worn outside of classrooms.
- Tattoos and Graffiti Tattoos (temporary or permanent) are not permitted. Students are not to mark their body in any way by writing on their skin.

Shoes/Footwear

Boys and Girls

Acceptable shoes for boys and girls are constructed of sturdy material, provide support for growing feet and cover the upper section of the foot for protection. They should be:

- Black leather
- Lace up school design
- Heeled up to 35mm

Sports shoes must be shock absorbing gym shoes (no volley OC's, Vans, skate shoes or canvas casual shoes). Black leather shoes must be regularly polished. Shoe laces must be tied at all times.

Unacceptable formal school shoes for girls include:

- Thin soled slip-on
- Laced 'ballet'
- Flat thin soled
- Shoes without heel
- Black runners / Sport shoes
- Canvas
- Boot style
- Velcro fastened
- Vans style shoes



Unacceptable formal school shoes for boys include:

- Black leather slip-on
- Pointed or long angular toe
- Black runners / Sport shoes without heel
- Canvas
- Boot style
- Velcro fastened
- Vans style shoes



Unacceptable sport shoes include:

- Volleys
- Van style shoes
- Skate shoes
- Canvas casual shoes/ Chucks
